Rules for bicycle safety



Reviewing the rules for bicycle safety can be a fun activity, especially if you have a bike available for children to demonstrate and practice the skills:

- 1. Obey all traffic signs and signals.
- 2. Ride single file on the right side, with the flow of traffic.
- **3.** Ride in a straight line. Don't do stunts.
- 4. Use proper hand signals when in traffic.
- 5. Slow down and look carefully before crossing intersections.
- 6. Be alert. Watch for other vehicles.
- 7. Don't shoot out of alleys and driveways.
- **8.** Give pedestrians the right of way.
- **9.** Don't carry another rider.
- 10. Don't hitch onto cars and trucks.
- 11. Be sure your bike has good brakes and a warning bell.
- 12. If riding at night, have a headlight on the front and a red reflector on the back.
- 13. Always wear a helmet.
